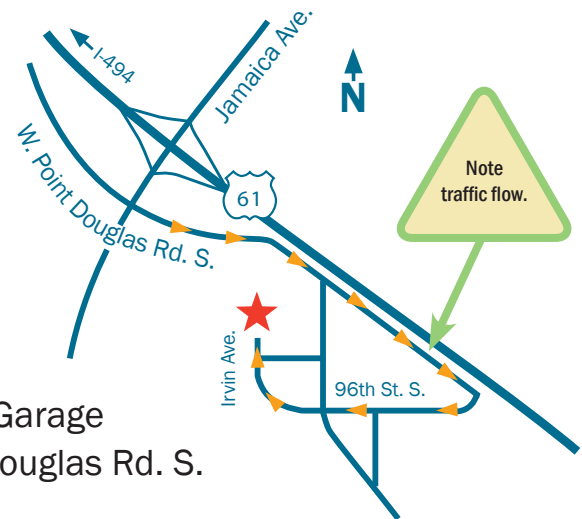


Document Shredding - FREE

Washington County is no longer accepting household hazardous materials at the Cottage Grove Spring Cleanup Day.

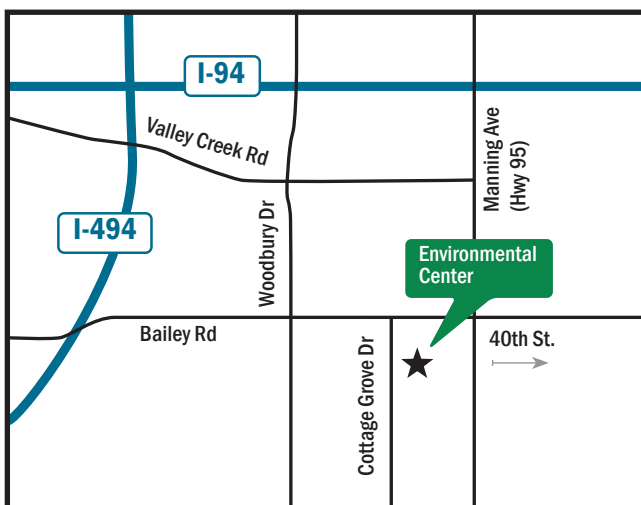
The Washington County Environmental Center is open year round for hazardous waste drop off. See reverse for location and hours.
